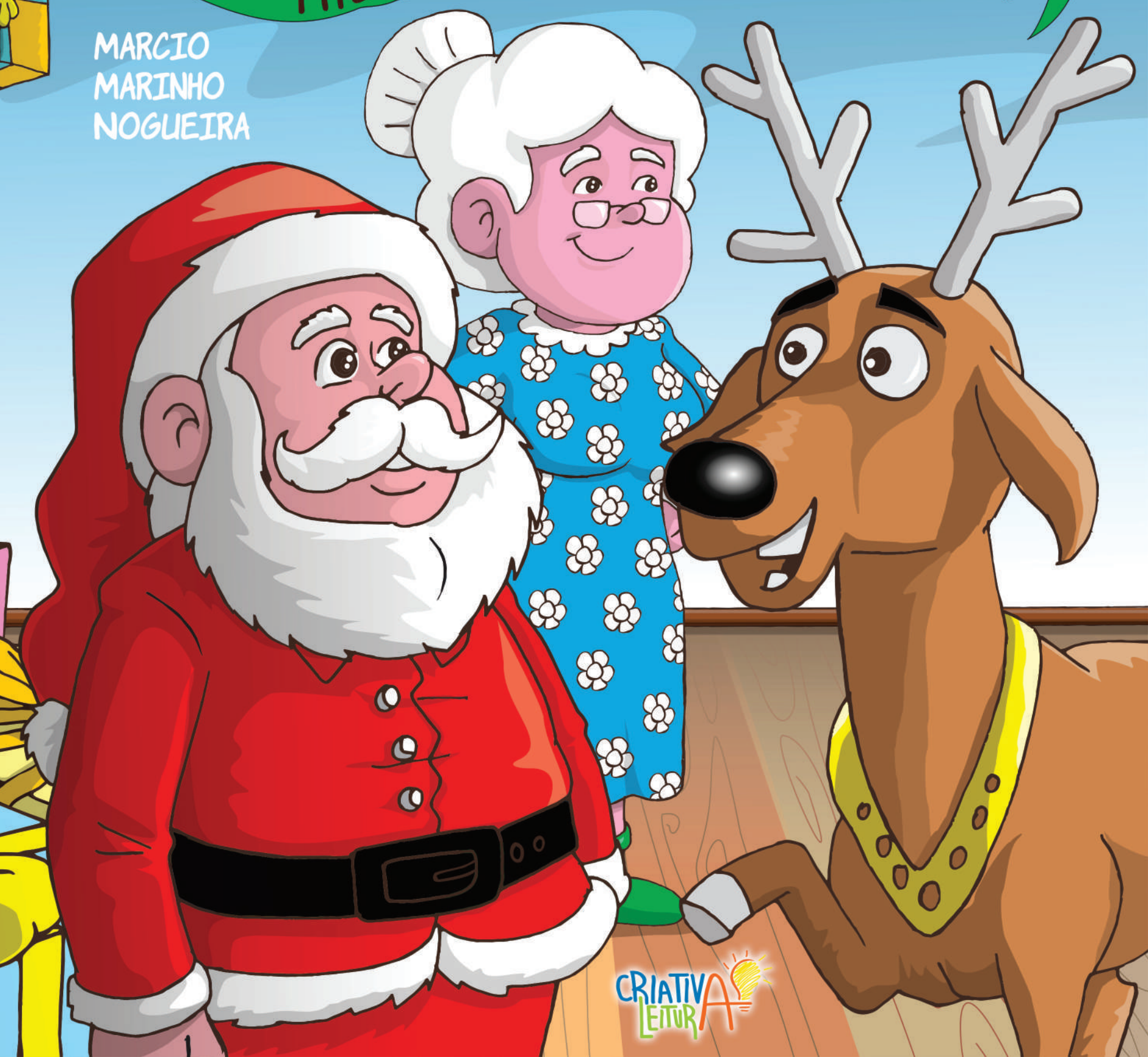


EVERYDAY'S CHRISTMAS

I think that is wrong!

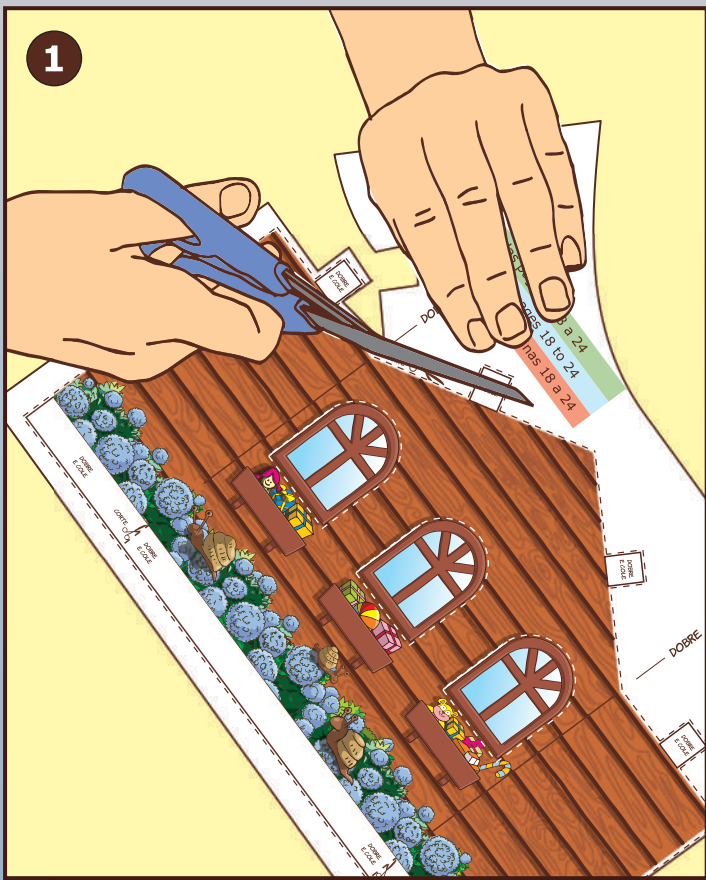

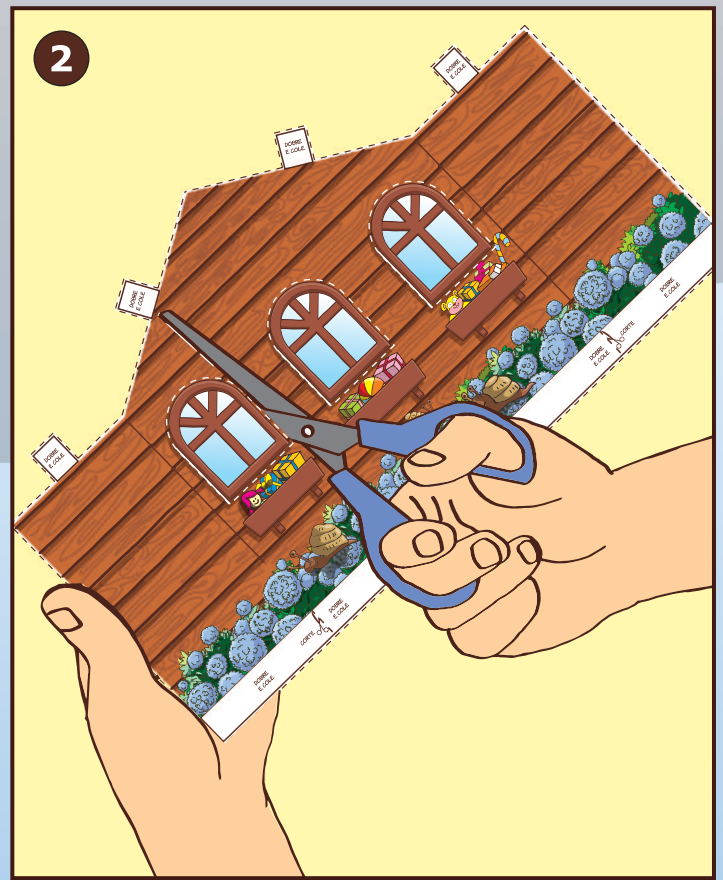

Adult supervision and assistance is recommended.

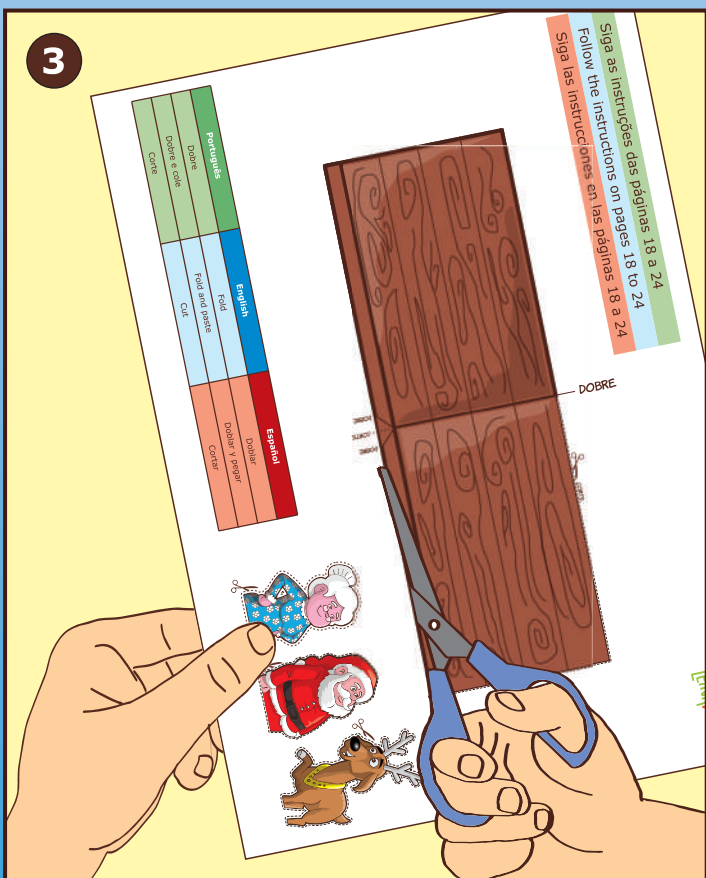




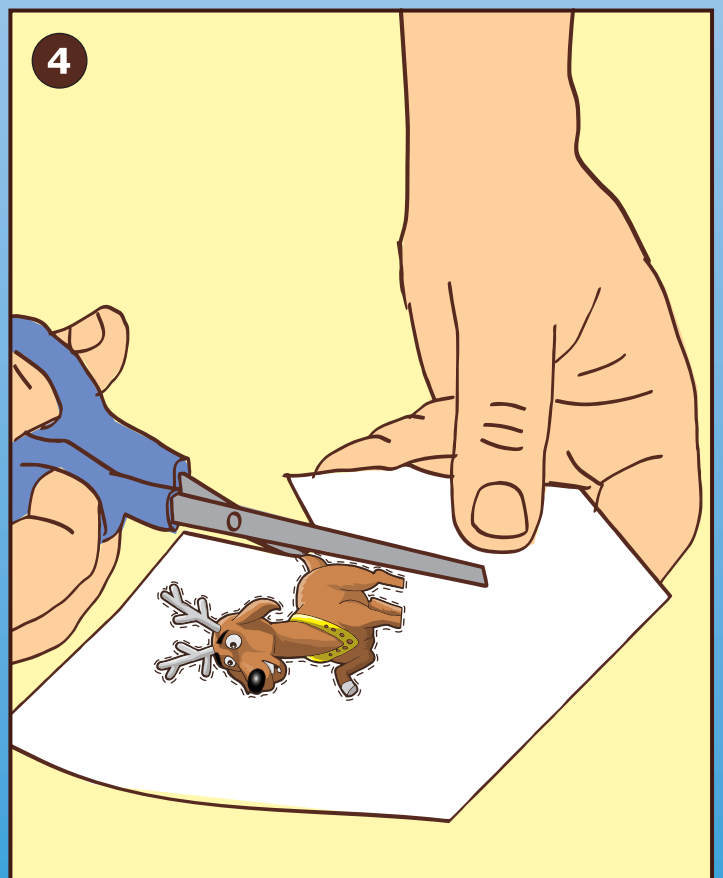
Cut the scenery in the dotted line. Ask for help so you don't get hurt while using the scissors.
